Edgar C. Kirsch, Jr., age 85 of Tecumseh, passed away February 2, 2010, after a prolonged illness. He was born March 9, 1924 in Battle Creek to Edgar C. Kirsch, Sr. and Lorena M. (Hussey) Kirsch who preceded him in death along with an infant brother and three sisters. He is survived by his wife of almost 64 years, Pauline (Boehm) Kirsch; son, David (Vicky) Kirsch of Tecumseh; granddaughter, Mary (Brian) Bruggenwirth and great-granddaughter Elizabeth Bruggenwirth of Adrian; a sister, Joyce Hall of Battle Creek and numerous nieces and nephews. Ed was a member of the Seventh Day Baptist Church in Battle Creek, and attended Gloria Dei Lutheran Church in Tecumseh. He served in the United States Army during WWII and earned a Bronze Star and a Purple Heart during service in France and Germany with the 925th Field Artillery Battalion of the 100th Infantry Division. He retired from Federal-Mogul Corporation in 1983 after twenty-six years of service in the cataloging, pricing and purchasing departments. A long-time amateur radio operator, Ed's callsign, W8SSH, was well known in the Coldwater and Battle Creek areas. Cremation has taken place and a private family memorial will be held at a later date.
